SUB: REQUISITION OF ADDITIONAL CONTINGENTS OF FEDERAL CONSTABULARY AND PAKISTAN RANGERS

Sir,

Reference to the letter received from Central Police Office, AJK, I am directed to bring to your immediate attention, the volatile security crisis engineered by the proscribed Jammu and Kashmir Joint Awami Action Committee (JK-JAAC) through its ongoing threats of long march, protest and agitational activities, that resulted miseries to the people of the State. The otherwise peaceful landscape reflects a deliberate, coordinated attempt to destabilize public peace across Azad Jammu & Kashmir, due to this miscreant element. So far, our forces suffered casualties, with 04 personnel embracing martyrdom and 174 others sustaining serious injuries.

2. The proscribed JAAC continues to maintain highly disruptive sit-ins in District Poonch/Rawalakot (Poonch Division), while attempting to mobilize public rallies in neighbouring districts. Concurrently, armed miscreants associated with the banned outfit are attempting to sabotage peace in the Muzaffarabad and Mirpur divisions. These elements, equipped with firearms, have actively targeted law enforcement personnel and civilians alike, triggering state-wide public order crisis. They have even resorted to setting fire to trucks transporting essential food items to AJK.

3. To effectively neutralize this escalating threat, sustain state authority, and reinforce overstretched security apparatus, the immediate deployment of following additional forces (over and above current deployments) is absolutely vital:

4. Given the gravity of the situation, immediate deployment of the aforementioned reinforcements is earnestly requested. Furthermore, to ensure operational readiness, 50% of the arriving force may be equipped with arms and ammunition, and the remaining 50% with anti-riot gear. Furthermore, any deficiencies in anti-riot gear within the designated units may kindly be bridged by provisioning the necessary equipment directly from central stocks before deployment.
